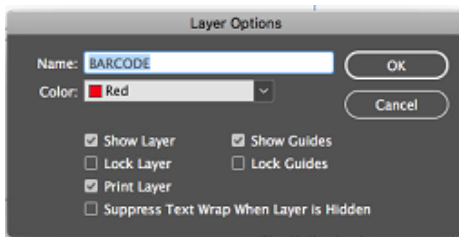
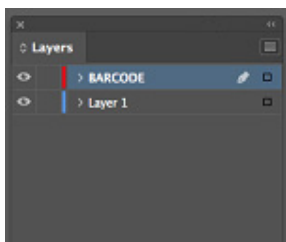


# Barcode Placement for DTP tutorial

1. Replace the existing barcode (source's or legacy one) by the new one provided by the client.
2. Cut (CTRL+X) the Barcode FRAME from the document (Not only the barcode Image).
3. Create a layer and name it "BARCODE". It is important that the new layer has "Show Layer" and "Print Layer" checkboxes selected:



4. Move the new layer to the top of the layer panel:



5. Paste the barcode you cut in the first step using the "Edit/Paste in place" option:



6. If the document has a text box with the PN placed above the barcode, remove this text box:



7. Expand the barcode's frame by the bottom so the Barcode Part number shows:



8. Expand the barcode frame to the sides and the top and verify that the complete barcode is shown:



9. Make sure that there isn't any frames or text boxes from the elements around the barcode overlapping with the barcode frame:
